Have you been turned down for your FAST card, and want to know what to do next? We have called the FAST office in Niagara Falls. According to the people there, this is what you need to do next:

Your correspondence letter should state which country denied your FAST card. Was it the Canadian side or the US side.

If it was the Canadian side, then you need to get all of your information, documents and a letter explaining why you would need the Re-dress Committee to read over and have another look at your application. The address for this is:

If it was the US side then you need to do the same as the above for them, but send your information to the following address:

If the driver is denied again after one of the above committees looks over the documents, they will send you a letter, either way. If it is another denial, the letter will give the driver details on what they need to do in order to get FAST approved.
